IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. BYOB -- please bring your own alcohol and drinks for the trail. Non-alcoholic beverages will be provided at meals.
2. Feed - all riders will be responsible for feeding their own horses - bring hay.
3. Sleeping Facilities - Bring your own
4. Limited Shower Facilities
5. NO DOGS OF ANY KIND OR SIZE. This is a ranch rule that we must respect. You will be asked to leave if the ranch discovers you have a dog.
6. Rental horses - contact Lee Graham. 760245-7695
7. Horse Pens - available for rent 1st come, 1st served at \$15 per night. Otherwise bring portable corrals or side tie to your trailer.
8. APPLICATION DEADLINE DATE: All applications must be postmarked no later than APRIL 10TH. In the event a rider must cancel before the deadline a refund less the \$20 application fee will be granted. NO REFUNDS AFTER APRIL 16TH. PLEASE GET YOUR APPLICATIONS IN EARLY SO WE CAN GET AN ACCURATE HEAD COUNT.
9. Early Bird Arrival - for those coming a significant distance, there is the option of arriving in camp Thursday afternoon. There will be no meals provided until Friday dinner. Please contact either Richard Johnson or Marcus Hochstetler to arrange early arrival.

LIABILITY RELEASE AND WAIVER AGREEMENT

In order to participate in any event sponsored by the *RANCHO CALIFORNIA CABALLEROS* all persons are required to read and sign this *LIABILITY RELEASE AND WAIVER AGREEMENT*. You should understand that Releases and Wavers are enforceable in California. In essences this agreement will prevent you from recovering Money damages in a Court of law and further if you should sue you will be subject to a lawsuit against you in the event that *RANCHO CALIFORNIA CABALLEROS* (aka. *RCC*), or it's members incur expenses defending against the lawsuit brought by you

You must read this release and initial where required and acknowledge that you understand it and that you agree to be bound by its terms and conditions in order to enter camp or participate in events.

Initial as Required

SCOPE Of AGREEMENT – This agreement shall be legally binding upon me and upon my heirs, executors, survivors, assigns and legal representatives. It shall be interpreted according to the Laws of California. It shall pertain to all activities of any kind and nature directly or indirectly associated with an event sponsored in whole or in part by *RCC*. The benefits of the agreement extend not only to the organization *RCC* but also to its officers, directors, members and guests.

ACTIVITIES INCLUDED - Many *RCC* events include horse activities. No horse can be said to be completely safe regardless of his prior history of behavior. When startled, surprised or provoked any horse may divert from his usual manner and revert to its natural survival instincts, and act in a manner that may be dangerous to its rider or a danger to those nearby. Because of the size and inherent nature of the horse a person is subject at all times to the possibility of serious injury which could include death, paralysis, fractures and other injuries which may well include major hospital expenses and long term, even permanent, effects from these injuries. The danger comes not only from one's own mount but from nearby horses controlled by others. **THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER AGREEMENT COVERS ALL HORSE RELATED INCIDENTS OR INJURIES.** There are other dangers of injury while in camp or on the trail. This Agreement is all encompassing and acts as a Release for **ANY INJURY REGARDLESS OF HOW SUSTAINED.** However if an individual harms another, either intentionally or as a result of gross negligence, then this Agreement and Release shall not be available as a defense by such person to a Lawsuit brought against such person.

MY REPRESENTATIONS TO RCC - By signing this Release and Agreement I represent to *RCC*, and to all others who participate in the event that I am experienced with horses and that I fully appreciate the nature of horses and the dangers associated with their use. I also promise that I will only engage in activities, whether involving horses or not, wherein I fully appreciate the risk of danger and that I **FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY ASSUME THE FULL RISK OF INJURY TO MYSELF UNDER ALL CIRCUMSTANCES, WHETHER ANTICIPATED BY ME OR NOT.**

To the extent that I might require Medical or Disability Insurance in the event of injury to me I represent to *RCC* that I personally have such insurance in force to protect me and my estate.

LIABILITY RELEASE AND WAIVER AGREEMENT

By signing my name below I do hereby promise **NOT TO SUE** and further to **RELEASE FROM ALL LIABILITY** for injury to me, or for any loss or damage occasioned by me, **RANCHO CALIFORNIA CABALLEROS** and its Officers Directors, Members and Guests (hereinafter referred to collectively as **RELEASEES**) **WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES** or otherwise while I am participating in a RCC event.

I hereby agree to **INDEMNIFY** and to **HOLD HARMLESS RELEASEES** from any loss, liability and damages, including Attorney Fees, in the event that I or my heirs, or personal representatives shall sue the **RELEASEES** as is prohibited by this **RELEASE**.

(Initial)

I hereby state that at the time of the signing of this **RELEASE** that I believe it to be valid and enforceable as a written contract and that I have signed it freely and voluntarily with the understanding that without my signature on this document I will not be permitted to enter the RCC camp or to participate in the event or any activities.

I understand that this **RELEASE AND AGREEMENT** consists of both sides of this page and I state that I am not relying upon any statements or representations made by any person that would in any way change or alter any aspect of this **RELEASE**. If I ask I will be provided with a copy of this **RELEASE**. **I UNDERSTAND THAT THIS RELEASE IS EFFECTIVE AS OF THE DATE OF DELIVERY TO RCC AND THAT IT SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT FOREVER UNLESS I SHALL DELIVER TO AN OFFICER OF RCC A WRITTEN REVOCATION. I MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY RCC EVENT IF I REVOKE THIS AGREEMENT.**
